## It became necessary to reach the ambush sites of anti-human elements

### 20 thousand martyrdoms for the Country

The cooperation of the Afghan government is also very important for this. After the establishment of Pakistan, 20 thousand martyrs were given for national security, 1000 martyrs had to be given due to wars and 10 thousand due to terrorism. These views were expressed by the President of Pakistan Ex-Servicemen Society, Said : Lieutenant General (Rtd), former Senator Abdul Qayyum.

He also said that now while four million ex- servicemen and 240 million Pakistanis are condemning the martyrs of the officers up to the lieutenant colonel of the defenders of their homeland, those elements are not patriotic citizens at all. Ridiculous comments are spreading on social media. Lieutenant General (ret'd) Abdul Qayyum said that Pakistan is the only country in the world which has been the victim of international terrorism more than a hundred times. Belongs to Pakistani children since 1947 There were more than 20 thousand martyrdoms for security are 10 thousand martyrdoms of them in 1948 - 1965 and 1971 and Kargil wars took place while 10 thousand martyrdoms took place due to terrorism.

This trend was once eradicated during the government of Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif, but unfortunately, terrorists have re-emerged. In the year 2021, 292 people were martyred, in 2022, 643 and in the year 2023, 1,000 people were killed by terrorists. From 2000 to 2019, 7 thousand 127 officers and youths of the security forces were martyred, but these martyrs and Ghazis sent 34 thousand 111 terrorists to hell.

The sad thing is that while in Afghanistan, the incidents of terrorism decreased by 75% and deaths by 58% after the Taliban regime, in Pakistan, deaths due to terrorism increased by 55%. 36 percent of these martyrdoms were caused by the BLA in Balochistan, whose attacks have also increased in intensity. Threats to national security are faced on political and diplomatic fronts, but the sad thing is that where the military institutions are making sacrifices, there is a war of seats in our houses of power. The time has come to start homeland security.
